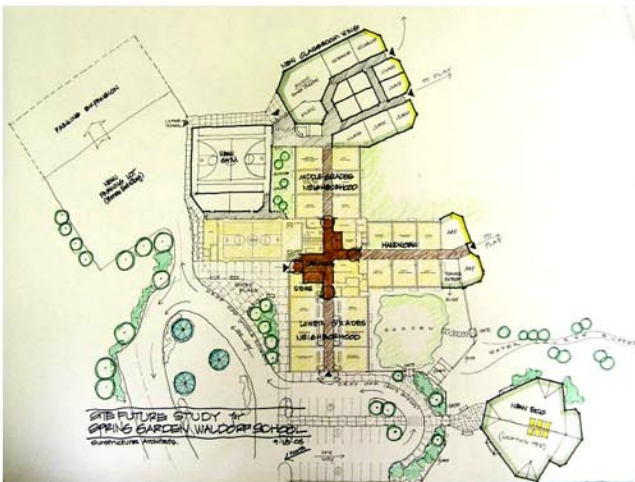


# Spring Garden Waldorf School

Spring Garden Waldorf School is a private, non-sectarian, coed school that provides education for a diverse group of children from age three through eighth grade. Housed in a 1960's vintage public school on a twelve acre site outside Copley, Ohio, SGWS engaged the services of Sunstructures Architects in 2005 to help guide the school through a planning process to improve the existing facility and to re-create it in a more Waldorf-appropriate environment and aesthetic. An interactive, inspiring program involving teachers, parents, Board members and students has envisioned a long-range master plan concept for the site and is currently in the process of designing a "model classroom" to be constructed in 2007-08 to act as a catalyst for fund-raising and community involvement.
