Unitarian Universalist Church of Ann Arbor

The 17,000 square foot religious education wing for the church is a model of green architecture that fits seamlessly with the existing sanctuary. The church design committee has elected to proceed with a LEED (Leadership in Energy and Energy and Environmental Design) Gold rating.

The building is carefully placed into the earth, while generous windows on the south elevation provide daylight for the classrooms, and a clerestory provides natural light for the social hallways.
